- Deliver technical implementation of sites,
- Deliver online design (user experience, interface design, web app integration with social media platforms) for each site,
- Recommendation of a CMS platform to deliver the required functionality,
- Integration of database management system to include the provision & installation of the DMS for each site and the provision of DMS configuration services (online tracking of requests, FOI, forms etc) for each PCC site,
- Provision of Search engine optimisation (SEO),
- Provision of a 2 year hosting and maintenance contract to the PCC websites inclusive of a warranty period of 4 months post launch date.
