Hampshire Clinical Commissioning Groups are seeking to contract with a suitably qualified provider for the delivery of Enteral Feeds and Associated Products and Services for its patient population across the whole CCG geography. Current contracts terminate in November /December 2016. The contract will be awarded for three years on NHS standard contract terms & conditions, with an option for two x 12 month contract extensions.

Key components of the service outlined in the specifications are:

- Supply of tube feeds, associated loan equipment and consumables and ONS supplied to the hospitals & community trusts in scope. NB: there will be no guarantee of ONS market share through primary care purchasers;
- Supply of tube feeds, associated loan equipment and consumables into the community where clinically appropriate and acceptable to patients in scope;
- home delivery service option offered to patients supported in their own homes or residential /care homes, for tube feeds and associated loan equipment and consumables;
- Where ONS products are required by a patient as part of a tube feed regimen, these too will be delivered via the home delivery system;
- company home nursing service;
- staff and patient training and support.
