Vann- og avløpsetaten (VAV) needs to establish 3 parallel framework agreements which shall cover the agency's requirements for geological ground surveys, geotechnical consultancy and engineering design for the agency's projects and departments. The objective of the procurement is to ensure that the agency human resources that are not available internally and that are necessary in order to implement the agency's construction projects.

VAV reserves the right to conduct separate tender contests, outside the framework agreement, for larger volumes and complicated plants, and when the agency finds it suitable.

VAV draws attention to the fact that the agency has separate framework agreements that include environmental technical surveys and geological consultancy and engineering design services.

The estimated value of the procurement is 20 000 000 NOK divided over a 4-year period. This is only an estimate and is not binding on VAV. The annual consumption will vary dependent on the agency's scope of assignments.

— The tenderer shall have a well-functioning quality system/management system appropriate for the content of the framework agreement.

Documentation requirement:

— Certificate for the company's quality system/management system issued by independent bodies that confirms that the tenderer fulfils certain quality assurance standards, for example ISO 9001 or equivalent. The contracting authority also accepts other documentation that shows that the tenderer has equivalent quality assurance measures. As a minimum, a general description of the system's content, including an overview of inspection plans and check-lists that are relevant for this contract, must be submitted.

— The following right to be responsible is required: Geotechnical engineering design development class 3 or equivalent.

Documentation requirement:

— Documentation of central certification for the necessary right to be responsible or documentation that the tenderer can fulfil the qualification requirements for the necessary right to be responsible.
