Bytoget (a new train operation entered into Flytoget from 10 December 2023) has a staff of 755 employees divided between train drivers and conductors. The proportion of men and women is approximately 70 % men and 30 % women.

The purpose of this procurement is to sign a framework agreement with a supplier who can meet Flytoget's needs for new uniforms for Bytoget.

This is the qualification phase. Tenders can be submitted after qualification for qualified suppliers, using 'Uniforms for Bytoget - Tender phase' starting 20 March 2023.

The scope of the procurement can be summarized as development, purchase and successive delivery of clothing that is part of Bytoget's uniform. The uniform is worn by train drivers, conductors and inspectors. The approximate total number of uniform wearers is 755 people. Delivery no later than November 10 2023.
