IV.1.1. Type of procedure

- Extreme urgency brought about by events unforeseeable for the contracting authority and in accordance with the strict conditions stated in the directive

Explanation:

1) Unforeseeable events

ECDC could not have diligently foreseen the Covid-19 pandemic, in particular in terms of its magnitude and speed of the spread of the virus. The urgent need of the Member States for support in whole genome sequencing (WGS) services for samples of the SARS-CoV-2 virus in the framework of a timely response was accordingly unforeseeable by the contracting authority.

2) Impossible to comply with the time limits in urgent cases (point 26)

Considering the rapid need of a very large volume of whole genome sequencing, in particular for Member States lacking sufficient capacity or capability, ECDC shall ensure support to the Member States in order to respond with impact to the pandemic in a timely and relevant manner. The time limits offered in urgent cases as described in point 26 would not have allowed this extremely urgent response.

3) The justification of such extreme urgency is not attributable to ECDC

The unforeseeable Covid-19 pandemic and the speed of the spread of the virus as well as new, emerging virus variants are the basis of the extremely urgent need of the Member States to whole genome sequencing services as response to the pandemic. The unforeseeable Covid-19 pandemic and this exceptional negotiated procedure are directly linked. Therefore, the justification of such extreme urgency is not attributable to the contracting authority.
