The Northern Ireland Environment Agency (NIEA) is an executive agency of the Department of the Environment. Within the Environmental Protection Directorate the Water Management Unit wished to establish contracts for the supply, delivery, installation, warranty and training of - Lot 1 – Supply, Delivery, Installation, Warranty and Training of One Gas Chromatographic Mass Spectrometer, (GCMS), Single Quadrupole System

The systems shall be used to perform analysis of WFD Annex 8/10 substances in environmental matrices down to extremely low limits of quantitation, sub ng/l in a number of cases.

The Contract shall provide for the purchase of each system inclusive of one year warranty and initial operator training. Following year 1 there shall be options to extend the contract on an annual basis for up to 7 years to cover extended warranty and maintenance.
