- Large diameter fitting;
- Insulation coupling;
- Fibre optic cable;
- SCADA.

Construction works for the PRT, which include site preparation; grading and fencing; civil construction works; access roads and roads within the facility; turn-key construction and fit-out of all buildings;

Construction of the onshore pipeline and Block Valve Station (BVS) from the first dry weld location in the landfall section to the scraper trap located within the PRT battery limits, including crossings and fibre optic cable installation;

Factory Acceptance Tests of equipment to be procured, tests on mechanical completion, Pre-commissioning and Commissioning;

Start-up of the facilities, including performance test for the complete PRT station.

- Lot 2: Onshore Pipeline (8-kilometre, 36-inch diameter).
