In addition, there is a need for a larger number of 'light' users of CMT and CAT that shall have reading access and possibly limited writing access. The tools (CMT and CAT) shall be totally integrated with each other and it shall be possible to integrate the tools with SPK's case and archive system Public 360 and the finance system Agresso. The contract will be valid for 2 years. The contracting authority has an option to extend the contract for 2 years and then have annual extensions (2+1+1+1+1). The maximum length is 8 years.
