VI.3.2. Review procedure

Precise information on deadline(s) for review procedures: The Council will incorporate a minimum 10 calendar-day standstill period at the point information on the award of contract is communicated to Tenderers. This period allows unsuccessful Tenderers to seek further debriefing from the Council before the contract is entered into. Such information should be requested from the address stated in Section I.1 above. If an appeal regarding the award of Contract has not been successfully resolved, the Public Contracts Regulations 2006 (SI 2006 No 5) as amended by the Public Contracts (Amendments) Regulations 2009 (SI 2009 No 2992) provide for aggrieved parties who have been harmed, or are at risk of harm, by a breach of the rules, to take action in the High Court (England, Wales and Northern Ireland). Any such action must be brought promptly. Where a Contract has not been entered into the Court may order the setting aside of the award decision or order the Council to amend any document and may award damages. If the Contract has been entered into the Court may order the

ineffectiveness of a Contract where serious rule breaches have occurred in addition to any fine, the Court may instead provide for alternative penalties, either contract shortening fines or both.
