Description: In this procurement there will be neither requirements nor award criterium for climate and environment, as the procurement has a climate footprint and an environmental impact that is immaterial, cf. the Utilities Regulations § 7-9 (5). The nature of the procurement in this case is the procurement of an electronic tool for carrying out calculations in the electricity network. Furthermore, the procurement involves maintenance and further development of such a tool, as well as operation and use of the tool. The work on maintenance and further development of the tool can be compared with a consultancy service without particular travel activities and is therefore considered to have immaterial climate footprint and environmental impact. However, if sub-supplier chains take into consideration, we can see that possible climate footprint and environmental impact may arise for the operation of the data centres on which the tool may be coughed. The supplier's influence over this energy consumption and the possible environmental impact is, however, very limited and it is aimless for the contracting authority to emphasise or set requirements in the requirement specifications for the environment in this procurement. Based on this, the procurement is, in its nature, to have immaterial climate footprint and environmental impact, and therefore falls under the exception rule in FF § 7-9 (5).
