The Training and Simulation Systems Programme (TSSP) team, part of the UK Ministry of Defence, intends to award a contract to Canadian Aviation Electronics (CAE UK Plc) to provide maintenance and support to the Warrior Gunnery Turret Trainer (WRGTT), Warrior Desk Top Trainer (WRDTT) and Artillery Fire Control Trainer (AFCT) all currently in service with UK MOD. It is considered that this Contract can be awarded using the negotiated procedure without prior publication pursuant to Article 28(1)(e) of Directive 2009/81/EC (Regulation 16(1)(a)(ii) of Defence and Security Public Contracts Regulations (DSPCR) 2011). This is due to CAE Inc. having exclusive rights to the software element of the requirement to which CAE UK Plc only have access, without which, such services cannot be provided. It is intended that the Contract will be for a period of 4 years with options for 2 further years, contracting in single year options.
