- be of solid construction,
- be capable of being placed under the required wheelset taking into account of existing equipment (e.g. motors, pumps, trolleys etc.),
- allow the vehicle to be hauled once the cradle is installed,
- should be designed to work with single axle and bogied vehicles,
- be capable of handling wheel sizes from 680 mm — 920 mm,
- withstand a maximum axle load of 20T,
- be easily transportable,
- theels and axles should conform to CME-TMS-301,
- the cradle should not infringe the gauge shown in figure 1,
- welding should conform to EN15085,
- all relevant certification should be provided to show that the cradle is capable of withstanding the loads specified,
- the design should be such that it will not interfere with axle counters (min wheel size of 300 mm).
