The Contracting Authority wishes to establish a multi-operator framework agreement for the delivery of virtual event platform services to host events (the 'Services').

The aim of the framework is to supply the Contracting Authority with virtual and hybrid event platform services for the multiple event types required throughout the academic year.

The service must include project management, live event production, rehearsals along with post-live event data and analytics inclusive and not limited to analysis of attendees, activity on sessions, registration data and feedback.

The technical elements of these events are of great importance to ensure security, back-up internet access systems, a choice of platforms for differing levels of functionality as required, easy access by participants/audience, and to maximise cost-effectiveness.

The type and nature of the events required are set out at a high level below.

1. Tier 1- Single campus/Information sessions/ Mini conferences/Hybrid element -
2. Tier 2 - Multi Campus (<6)/Multi Streams/ Large conferences/Hybrid
3. Tier 3 - TU events/Larger scale Multi Campus (>6)/Hybrid
