Bergen Vann KF shall enter into framework agreement (without mini-competition) on diving services. The services shall be executed in Bergen, and Os Kommune.

The diving services shall primarily be used to check and repair sewage pipes/inverted siphons. In many cases it will be necessary to use a barge/boat to be able to carry out the assignments.
