This subproject, and this procurement process, of the overall ASWF project concerns the communication suite. This is the internal and external communication system that will be installed on the ASWF. This communication suite includes antenna tuning units, voice terminals and radio communication systems. The antennas themselves are Government Furnished Equipment, the interfaces with the antennas are a part of this Subproject. The communication suite will also enable information exchange between on board users, as well as provide communication links between on board users and external users (other ships, aircraft and shore stations).
