Explanation:

In accordance with Regulation 72(1)(c) this extension is required due to unforeseen circumstances. The services that this requirement covers works closely with the services provided by the Sexual Assault Referral Centre in Lincolnshire, which is just being acquired by NHS England with an expected start date of 1.10.2017. The intention was originally to procure the ISVA for the SARC simultaneously with the PCC for Lincolnshire requirement as a joint procurement which would have required the specification to be broadened and therefore a 6 month extension to the PCC's current contract was originally intended to allow enough time to

complete an EU compliant collaborative tender process for both elements from October 2017. The ISVA is now being procured separately to the PCC element, however a 6 month contract is still required in order to run an EU compliant tender process for the period from 1.10.2017. The extension does not affect the overall nature of the contract as it is simply a change to the contract period. All other elements of the Contract remain the same. The increase in price is less than 50 % of the original contract value.
