2.1. Procedure

Title: LC-MS/MS for drug and alcohol testing in spit at Helse Bergen HF

Description: The objective of the procurement is to procure 2 LC-MS/MS-instruments with dashboards and PCs for the Department of Medical Biochemistry and Pharmacology at Haukeland University Hospital, Bergen Health Trust. The instruments shall have very high sensitivity, suitable ion source and must be equipped with UHPLC.

Main features of the procedure: The equipment shall be placed in the section for doctor and drug and alcohol analyses and it shall be used in development and routine analysis of new methods. Primary use is drug and alcohol analyses in spit, annually up to 15,000 samples per instrument. 4,000 samples are expected per annum for kiral analyses of amphetamines in spit and urine. The equipment shall be set up for use with both analysis methods. Planned analyses of spit with measuring areas are listed in Annex 5 - Overview of analytes and planned measurement areas. The measurement areas are expected to be achieved to the greatest possible degree, with acceptable precision (under 15%). The sample taking equipment that is used for spit samples is Abbott Quantisal, which dilutes the sample four times and therefore sets high requirements for the sensitivity of the equipment. Fluid-fluid extraction (LLE) is planned to be used with pipetting robots for sample preparation. In the long term it is desirable to change to protein precipitation. The equipment must be suitable for this. Future use may also include drug and alcohol analyses in urine, in this case sample preparation with enzymatic hydrolysis and subsequent dilution will be used. The division also carries out research analyses in different sample matrixes (urine, spit, serum, plasma, whole blood, tissue and ventricle aspirate) with human and animal origin. The equipment must be able to deliver quantitative analysis results of high quality with these sample matrixes. The contract also includes options for service, service courses, three instruments, record hotel, ion sources and relevant software.
