Main features of the procedure: The aim of the procurement is to cover Statsbygg's need for control and service for fire alarms, emergency lights and speech warning systems in Oslo and the surrounding area. This procurement is for installations where the system supplier is Autronica. The contract shall be used for annual inspections and ongoing service and maintenance. In addition the contract can also be used for switching components and making expansions on the existing installations.
