Main features of the procedure: GENERAL Fingrid Oyj, the Finnish national transmission system operator, is initiating this procurement process for 400 kV 400 MVA system transformers with the intended delivery between years 2029-2032 for existing and new substations in various locations in Finland. With this invitation to participate Fingrid is looking for capable and interested candidates to provide the needed power transformers. In our operating model, the network of services and good suppliers as well as good co-operation between different contractual partners are especially important.
