Main activities in the assignment:

- Felling and sale of timber
- Road construction and road maintenance on roads that need to be used in the contract period The assignment is limited to permanent tractor roads, winter vehicle roads, winter maintenance, and repair of permanent roads after operations.
- Reforestation in the form of establishing rejuvenation of the felled areas
- Reforestation in established rejuvenation

The assignment also includes obtaining forest plants for first 2.5 years in the next contract period, i.e., for 2027, 2028, and until the spring planting in 2029.

The assignment covers part of Innlandet County.

The assignment includes forestry services on land belonging to Statskog SF and Statskog Glomma AS.

Norwegian tenderers shall present a tax and VAT certificate from the Norwegian Tax Authority. The certificate must not be older than 6 months from the tender deadline.

Economic and financial capacity

Tenderers must have sufficient economical and financial capacity. This is to be documented through the following. The company's annual accounts for the last three years including: The board's annual reports, profit and loss accounting, balance, notes, and the auditor's report. If a tenderer has any valid reasons for not being able to provide the documentation requested by Statskog, the tenderer may prove its economic and financial position with any other document that is acceptable to Statskog. If a tenderer has such valid reasons, he may contact Statskog in writing in order to clarify which other documentation is acceptable.

III.1.3. Technical and professional ability

List and brief description of selection criteria:

The portion of the contract to be performed by sub-contractors.

The tenderer is considering to leave the following part (percentage) of the contract to sub-suppliers. Technical and professional qualification requirements - assignments in the last three years.

Tenderers must give an overview of the largest and most important assignments carried out in the last three years, including the assignments' dates, recipients, and values. If a tenderer believes he has a valid reason as to why he cannot present such an overview as requested by Statskog, he can contact Statskog in writing in order to clarify whether this is a reason that Statskog can accept.

Requirements for technical and professional qualifications - competence and experience. Tenderers must provide information on who will be responsible for the assignment and the competence and experience of those who will carry out the assignment, including sub-suppliers. Tenderers must document competence within the Norwegian PEFC Forestry Standard through a course certificate, attestations, or declarations. This concerns all department managers/forestry managers, machine operators, and work managers within reforestation. Completed PEFC courses cannot be older than five years. The Norwegian PEFC Forestry Standard will be revised in 2022. Tenderers must have a plan so that department managers/forestry managers, machine operators, and work managers within reforestation can attend a new PEFC course within one year of the new standard being approved. Information on this must be given in the account. Tenderers must be certified in accordance with ISO 14001 with the Norwegian PEFC Forestry Standard as the environmental requirement by the tender deadline. Tenderers must be certified in accordance with ISO 9001 by the tender deadline.

Technical and professional qualification requirements - machines, tools, and technical equipment.

Tenderers must provide an overview of the machines, tools and technical equipment that they can use, as documentation that the assignment can be executed in a satisfactory way.

Tenderers must describe whether the machines and equipment are equipped with the 'Best available technology' (BAT) where relevant, based on the risk of pollution and other serious environmental errors, cf. the Norwegian PEFC Forestry Standard. Information on this must be given in the account. Tenderers must have the use of felling machines with modern systems for data based marking for cross-cutting. Information on this must be given in the account.
