The Kemnal Academies Trust (TKAT) is made up of 44 academies spread across the South East of England and split into 5 regions — TKAT Essex, TKAT City, TKAT East, TKAT Central and TKAT Coast. This tender has a 2 fold purpose to set up a Framework Agreement for catering services which all TKAT academies can access in each of the 5 regions and to appoint service providers for the academies in the TKAT City Region for whom contracts (in the main) need to be awarded for the commencement of the 2019/20 academic year. TKAT City Region covers academies based in the Bexley, Bromley, and Swanley area of Kent and consist of 4 primary academies (Grays Farm, Horizon, Royal Park, Shenstone) and 3 secondary academies (Cleeve Park School and Cleeve Meadow School, Kemnal Technology College and Orchards).
