This is because Selex ES Ltd is the UK Ministry of Defence's Design Organisation (DO) for its Skyshadow 2 ECM system, is required to ensure that the equipment meets airworthiness and safety certification requirements and platform usage requirements, is a Design Approved Organisation Scheme (DAOS) member in respect of this ECM system and only Selex ES Limited has the technical knowledge and equipment expertise to provide Technical Tasking and Support (to include Obsolescence Investigation and Modification and Design), Repair and Overhaul and Spares Supply services to the MOD in respect of Skyshadow 2.
