The duration of the Dynamic Purchasing System for Long Term Taxi Services is 24 months with the option to extend for two further periods of 12 months. It is envisaged that the total expenditure over the full 48 month duration will be c. 2 000 000 GBP.

The Dynamic Purchasing System (DPS) shall remain open for new requests to participate from suitable operators for its entire duration.

Operators who meet the minimum selection criteria shall be admitted to the DPS and invited to further competitions as and when requirements for services are made.

This Dynamic Purchasing System is being run under the Restricted Procedure in accordance with PCR2015.
