VI.4.2. Review procedure

Precise information on deadline(s) for review procedures: PCH will allow a period of at least ten (10) calendar days between the date it gives notice to candidates of the decision to award the proposed agreement and the date on which it proposes to conclude the agreement. If, by midnight at the end of the second working day of the ten (10) day standstill period, PCH receives a request in writing from a candidate as to why it was not successful, PCH is required to provide additional information to the candidate.
