In addition to parliamentary deputies and their staff these buildings welcomed approximately 148,000 visitors to Strasbourg in 2018.

This contract covers fire safety and personal assistance services applying regulations against the risks of fire and panic, and personal assistance, including controlling fire safety. The hourly volume is estimated at ± 134,000/year.
