The contracting authority plans to enter into a contract with one tenderer. Assembly of torches is planned for the contracting authority to carry out themselves. The contract contains a binding procurement volume for ordering both L1 - pole torches and L2 - wall torches, and the procurement of several torches of both types during the contract period.
