The contracting authority would like enter into a contract for the procurement and delivery of play apparatuses.

Requirements for the products are stated in Annex 1 Attachment 1 - The Contracting Authority's Requirements Specification and Description of the Tenderer's Solution.

The procurement is not split into lots, and tenderers must submit tenders for all product groups, cf. SSA-R Annex 5, Appendix 1 - Price Sheet.

The estimated scope of the framework agreement is approx. 750,000 - 1,500,000 excluding VAT a year. The estimate is based on previous procurements, with consideration to the number of municipalities in the procurement cooperation. The scope is only an estimate and is not binding for the contracting authority.

The maximum financial limit for the framework agreement (including the option years) is NOK 12,000,000 excluding VAT. This maximum financial limit has been set in order to ensure necessary limits if the needs are greater than expected.

The contracting authority reserves the right to carry out a credit assessment from Experian or a similar agency.

III.1.3. Technical and professional ability

1) Implementation ability. Tenderers must have sufficient implementation ability to fulfil the contract.

2) Reference descriptions. Tenderers shall have valuable experience from relevant and comparable deliveries.

Relevant and comparable deliveries mean assignments of the same scope and size.

3) Quality assurance/management system. Tenderers must have a documented and implemented satisfactory quality assurance/management system.

4) Environmental management system. Tenderers must have a documented and implemented environmental management system.

5) HSE system. Tenderers must have a documented and implemented environmental management system.

Minimum level(s) of standards possibly required:

An account of the company's core competence related to the scope of the delivery.

3) A short description of the tenderer's quality assurance/management system.

Tenderers cannot rely on other companies to fulfil this qualification requirement.

If a tenderer is certified in accordance with ISO 9001 or equivalent quality assurance certificate, it is sufficient to attach a copy of the valid certificate.

4) A brief description of the tenderer's environmental management system that the tenderer will use to fulfil this contract.
