The framework will be available for all Academies, main stream Schools and Colleges still under Local Authority control to use and will be open to use by all other public sector bodies in the UK. The main aim of the framework is to introduce competition and give a European Procurement Regulations Compliant route to market for all public sector bodies to use. South Hunsley School and Sixth form College is an outstanding academy with over 2 000 students. This is expected to increase to 2,250 students over the next 5-10 years.
