— identification, assessment and treatment of adults (aged 18+) with long term conditions or medically unexplained symptoms to help them deal with the psychological impacts of their condition(s).

The commissioners will encourage innovation and use of technology within service delivery. They are seeking patient centred solutions for the provision of this service with the following aims:

— early intervention and promotion of self-directed support and recovery;

— provision of the least intrusive, most effective intervention first;

— development of the use of technology and digital platforms to engage patients who prefer this approach;

— active engagement and participation with long term conditions services and pathways to increase the number of long term conditions patients in to IAPT;

— specific focus on increasing the number of older people and Black, Asian and minority ethnic (BAME) people receiving treatment.
