Kvinnherad library currently has a book bus that is 7,75 metres long, 2,42 wide and max. 7,5 tons. It drives a total of approx. 12 000 km per annum. The bus has room for 2 000 media units (books, film, audio) and is run by a librarian. In autumn 2015 the bus had 35 stopping place every 14 days, where 26 of the stops were connected to schools or nurseries. The number of loans is very high, in 2015 — 32 975. The bus shall now be replaced due to wear, rust and age.

Functionality — general:

The library bus must be easy to run and have flexible and future orientated systems for meeting the functions and requirements that users currently have and will have in the future. Particular consideration will be given to good functionality. We would particularly like the bus to be quiet, easy to get books and other material in and out of.

The library bus shall be delivered fully registered. It shall be possible to have a partition between the driver's cab and the load as required by the Norwegian government.

The library bus shall be built as a lorry/bus chassis and the body is to be built from stainless steel/galvanised material. The library bus must be treated for corrosion and it must have a programme for corrosion protection.

The following vital measurements are wanted for the body: Greatest length: 10,0 m.

Description of options: Option 1: 5 extra mobile shelf units with lockable wheels shall be delivered for use when replacing material in the library bus. It is very important that all of these shelves on wheels have sufficient fastenings, so that they are kept in place when the bus is moving, without having to be fastened with straps.

Option 3: There shall be 2 chairs that can be raised and lowered for persons who work at the counter.

Option 4: Service/maintenance contract.
