The Contracting Authority shall be authorised to contact the stated contact persons in order to clarify any questions of relevance to the assignment/contract.

Systems and routines that ensure low environmental impact when performing the delivery are required. Documented by: Description of the business's procedures and systems related to waste, transport, chemical handling, and procurement. If the routines are described in the company's environmental management system according to ISO 14001 or equivalent 3rd party verified systems, the valid certificate, as well as a copy of relevant procedures, must be submitted.

The tenderer is required to have established control systems and routines for quality assurance of the services included in the contract.
