The contract shall be concluded for an initial duration of 1 year and may be renewed tacitly a maximum of 4 times, each time for a period of 1 year. The total duration of the contract may not exceed 5 years. Under Article 126(1)(f) and Article 126(3) of the Commission Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 2342/2002 of 23.4.2002 laying down detailed implementing rules, the contracting authority may use a negotiated procedure for the award of new services which entail the repetition of similar services entrusted to the contractor who was awarded the original contract. That procedure may be used only during the 3 years following the conclusion of the original contract.
