- (a) a document detailing the composition and constitution of the entity or the legal form of this cooperation in the event they are awarded the contract;
- (b) a letter signed by each grouping member, stating that they undertake to carry out the work, and specifying their role, qualifications and experience. The lead member must be duly authorised to submit the tender on behalf of the other members of the grouping.

Tenderers who fail to provide these documents may be automatically excluded.

These requirements also apply to subcontractors to whom more than 20 % of the estimated total value of the contract will be subcontracted.
