The supply and installation works for approximately 63 automatic high speed shutter doors at Northfields and Cockfosters Depots. Trials of doors have been carried out and the door performance specifications are now fixed, including as follows:

1/ To be suitable for depot operating requirements, door opening speed to be between 1.2 and 2.4 m/second. Closing speed 1.2 m/second.

2/ Due to site exposure to elements, doors must be designed to withstand >1 000 N /m<sup>2</sup> class 5 wind pressure (80 mph) and conforms to European Norms EN 12424.

3/ Dimensions will be approximately 4 000 mm x 4 000 mm.

3/ A full specification will be issued at tender stage.
