4) If a tenderer is a company, the company shall be a legally established company.

If a tenderer consists of a group of companies, the companies that are the group participants shall be legally established. Tenderers that are obliged to register in accordance with the Company Registration Act shall enclose documentation of registration.

infrastructure such as, for example, BKK or the Water and Sewage Department. The excavation contract did not have to be for the installation of the same type of pipe as in this contract.

Emphasis is put on the fact that the requirement for the tenderer's experience applies to the tenderer as such, i.e. the company (or the group of companies) that stand as the tenderer in the competition.

2) A good and well functioning quality assurance system is required for the services that shall be provided.
