The value of the award has changed considerably from that first advertised. The contract being tendered was for 2 Multi-Academy Trusts with a total of 5 sites between them. The bids submitted have been considered by all 5 and are only considered to be 'economically advantageous' for 2 of the 5. This has resulted in the value being significantly lower than the initial estimated total value of the contract.
