Tenderers shall carry out all assignments and obligations, as specified and that are naturally associated, in an efficient, independent and professional manner and in accordance with good brokerage practice. The service shall take into account Nofima's needs, possibilities and challenges. A contract shall be signed with one tenderer. A comprehensive description of the assignment is given in Annex 1, requirement specifications.

The financial strength will be assessed in relation to turnover, operating degree, solidity and liquidity. • If there is doubt about whether the tenderer fulfils the requirement, the contracting authority may require further documentation of the financial capacity.
