The service will include the comprehensive provision of sterile services including the cleaning of surgical instruments operating to Medical Devices Directive (93/42/EEC, as amended by Directive 2007/47/EEC) (MDD) and ISO 13485/2003 standards, the delivery and collection of surgical instruments and the provision of associated support services and supplies to the Trust. At present the Trust has

an in house service for for provision of sterilisation services.
