Project Aims:

To provide SAC with an integrated SAC-wide telephony system capable of supporting new telephony features, improving connectivity, functionality, productivity, manageability and operating costs. The platform for this structure will be a converged network with telephony and data communications both being delivered over the corporate network infrastructure.

Project Objectives:

- IP Telephony (IPT) over the corporate data network,
- SIP Trunks providing access to PSTN services over the data network and the ability to have geographic phone numbers for most UK exchanges,
- Unified communications (UC) providing presence, Instant messaging, Unified conferencing and one number reach,
- Centralised management,
- Centralised call logging and traffic management,
- Regional site resilience where applicable,
- Integration of calls from SAC Telephone system to SAC mobiles,
- Implement Quality of Service,
- Utilise Power over Ethernet where possible.

- Reduction in number of independent phone systems currently installed,
- Reduced telephony bills across SAC,
- Improved telecommunications and messaging within SAC,
- Centralised management of SAC's telephony estate.
