Tenderers can document experience by referring to the competence of the personnel that he can use for this assignment, including experience that has been acquired while the personnel carried out services for another service provider. 2) The tenderer must have a good and well-functioning quality assurance and management system for the services that will be provided.

Documentation requirement:

Tenderers must submit documentation of their quality assurance system and management system. The following documentation will be accepted: Certificates for the tenderer's quality assurance/quality management system issued by independent bodies confirming that the tenderer meets the quality assurance standards according to ISO 9001 or equivalent, or a description that as a minimum includes the company's procedures/routines for deviation and claims management, authorisation of sub-contractors, the process from reception and registration of orders up until delivery to the customer has taken place.

3) The tenderer must have an environmental management system.

Documentation requirement:

Tenderers must submit documentation of their environment management system. The following documentation will be accepted: Valid attestation/certificates issued by independent bodies (e.g. ISO 14001, EMAS, Eco-Lighthouse or equivalent), or a description of the tenderer's own environmental management system. (a) an environmental policy that is determined by the management;
