NHS Bromley are procuring a new community musculoskeletal services for patients registered with and referred by a Bromley Clinical Commissioning Group GP. The contract will be for 2 years with optional 1 year extension

Bromley CCG are led by local NHS doctors and cover a population of over 326,000 from Beckenham to Biggin Hill. The CCG looks after a growing population with increasing numbers of young children and older people and greater life expectancy.

The main objective of the Service is to provide musculoskeletal (MSK) triage, assessment and treatment for adults registered with and referred by a Bromley Clinical Commissioning Group GP. To ensure the Service meets local patients' needs across the local health economy, the following objectives should be achieved:

— To promote the independence, choice, dignity, privacy, respect and participation of service users

— To acknowledge and respect a service user's gender, sexual orientation, age, physical or mental health ability, race, religion, culture, social background and lifestyle

— To provide a service that gives value-for-money based on sound economic practice and flexibility of provision

— To provide front-end clinical triage of all Musculoskeletal (Orthopaedics, Rheumatology and Physiotherapy) GP referrals

— To provide Physiotherapy assessment and treatment for adults registered with a Bromley CCG GP with conditions of musculoskeletal origin affecting the lower back, shoulder, hip, knee and other conditions

— To maintain the current high activity level within the Service and to manage rising demand through innovative practice eg. group sessions, educating GPs to manage patients in primary care etc

— To deliver improved access – patients to be seen in local and familiar settings offering a

wider range of clinic times

— To support the management of patients within GP practice by up-skilling GPs through academic events, MSK Club and other ad hoc GP training events

— To address health and inequality issues

— To provide improved patient outcomes due to timely access to high quality Physiotherapy assessment and treatment

— To offer better management of 'revolving door' patients
