The Authority will select a single contractor to enter into the ICCS and Mobilising contract with Cambridgeshire Fire and Rescue Service (the Authority). Following the evaluation of SQ responses the Authority will shortlist the 6 highest scoring candidates to be invited to submit initial tenders. The Authority is not prescribing any specific technologies and/or hosting arrangements and all technical solutions being put forward either cloud based or hosted by the Authority will be considered.

The procurement is being conducted under Competitive Procedure with Negotiation (Regulation 29 of the Public Contract Regulations) and in accordance with Regulation 29 (15) the Authority reserves the right and has a strong desire to award the contracts on the basis of initial tender without negotiation.

Following award of contract and on completion of implementation (up to 18 months) the contract will run for a period of 5 years from the operational services commencement date (go live), with the option to extend for a up to 2 periods of up to 24 months each.
