This contract will not be divided into Lots as the Authority requires a single contractor (or consortia) to manage the entire Service.

As part of the verification process, the tenderer that meets all the Mandatory Requirements, achieves the highest score will be required to provide a working demonstration of their proposed hardware. Costs for hosting this demonstration for up to a party of 10 people for approx. 1 day (10:00-17:00) must be borne by the tenderer.

This demonstration will take place at ICS, Lislea Drive, Belfast, BT09 7JG and must be within 2 weeks of a request from the Client to hold such a verification exercise, unless otherwise

agreed. The proposed hardware must be demonstrated comprehensively against those mandatory requirements identified for verification within the Specification. This is to ensure that the proposed hardware meets the requirements. The tenderer will bear any costs relating to travelling to the location and any associated accommodation costs.

This exercise will be used to confirm the response of the preferred bidder. In the event that any Mandatory Requirements are amended to a Fail then the next highest scoring tenderer will be asked to provide a working demonstration of their proposed hardware. The tenderer with the highest scoring compliant bid and system that successfully passes the verification process will then be awarded the contract.
