EBN wants to make a constructive contribution to the acceleration of the energy transition. Under the heading “Energising the transition” EBN is now focusing on: “the sustainable and safe development of natural gas and oil reserves in the Netherlands, safe and sustainable reuse and decommissioning of disused infrastructure, and the use of sustainable forms of energy from the subsurface such as geothermal energy”.

EBN aims to have a leading role in realizing the energy transition and ensuring that the energy demand of the Netherlands can be met in a sustainable, stable and affordable way. Part of this role is carrying out activities for the exploration of the subsurface to identify possibilities to develop geothermal projects.

EBN has been tasked together with TNO by EZK to map the subsurface in areas where the existing seismic data coverage is sparse, in order to better map, study and understand the potential for geothermal energy and accelerate development of geothermal energy in the Netherlands. The scope of this tendering procedure consists of acquisition of several seismic lines onshore in the Netherlands.
