#### II.1.4. Short description of the contract or purchase(s)

Procure Plus (PP) is a social housing regeneration consortium based in the North West of England. PP has formed an alliance with Cumbria Housing Partners (CHP), Procure Plus Associates (PPAL) and Efficiency North (EN). This alliance is known collectively as Re:allies. Subject to business requirement this alliance may from time to time include other housing associations and/or social housing consortia in the United Kingdom.

Re:allies brings together expertise from across the North of England to deliver a highly efficient approach to procurement and regeneration at a local level. Further additional social housing consortia may join the Re:allies alliance from time to time. PP have now established a framework agreement with the winning supplier for the purposes of supplying a full and diverse range and brand of goods and materials for the completion of responsive repairs, maintenance and occasional planned works to social housing. The framework agreement and call off contracts will operate on a cost price mechanism whereby goods and materials are supplied at the exact price paid by the supplier, having taken into account all rebates, contract support, marketing and other monies returned or offset to the supplier against the volume of purchases, with the application of an agreed margin. The winning supplier will provide the goods and materials via a bespoke supply solution that is tailored to meet the requirements of individual customers or a group of customers acting as a collaborative.

The framework agreement will be in place for a period of four years and will not be extended beyond this period, however contracts called-off under the framework agreement may, where appropriate, continue beyond the 4 year term of the framework.

The framework agreement will also be available for use by organisations who are party to PP's current and future framework agreements including but not limited to framework agreements for the completion of gas servicing and repair, responsive repairs, new build, voids and various installation and repair works from time to time ("Other Framework Agreements"). The use of the framework agreement will be under licence from PP and the organisation's entitlement to enter into a call off contract will end if the organisation ceases

to be a party to all of the Other Framework Agreements. A list of the organisations that are currently party to Other Framework Agreements is set out in section VI.3 of this Notice.
