The contract will be valid for 2 years with an option for Ringsaker Municipality (hereafter the contracting authority) to extend for a further 1+1 year. The estimated value over a four-year period is NOK 2 million. There is no procurement obligation under the contract, and the amount can be both lower and higher, depending on the contracting authority's adopted budgets and activities. The upper total limit under the contract is set to NOK 3 million.

3) Tenderers must have a quality assurance system suitable for the delivery. Documentation requirement: A description of the tenderer's methods for quality assurance. If a tenderer is certified in accordance with ISO 9001 or equivalent quality assurance certification, it is sufficient to attach a copy of the valid certificate ISO 9001 or equivalent quality assurance certificate, cf. the PPR section 16-7 (1), cf.
