Title: Shelter West IKS

Description: Tysvær municipality (also called the "Contracting Authority") invites tenderers to participate in prequalification - application for participation in the competition for the procurement of a contract for engineering design services for and the construction of a new shelter. The competition will be held in accordance with the Act from 17 June 2016 no. 73 on public procurements and regulations 12 August 2016 no. 974 on public procurements (the procurement freeze) parts I and part III. The chosen procurement procedure is a "negotiated procedure" in two stages. The tenderers are encouraged, and responsible for, to go through the tender documentation carefully and get in the competition rules. If the tender documentation is considered unclear, tenderers are encouraged to ask questions to the contracting authority.

Main features of the procedure: Shelter Vest IKS, which is owned by 16 municipalities and offers a statutory and 24 hour shelter offer to around 183,000 inhabitants, shall be co-housed in a new and purpose-built shelter in Aksdal. The new building shall be located in Aksdal and it will be designed to ensure safety, screening and good residential functions for both adults and children. The project is part of the owner municipalities' decision to establish a joint and co-localised shelter for the region. The building is owned by Tysvær municipality, which is also carrying out the procurement on behalf of the 16 owner municipalities. Shelter West IKS will rent the building and run the shelter offer. The procurement shall cover the Contracting Authority's need for establishing a new shelter in Aksdal. Further information on the assignment is in Annex 1 - Service Description. A dialogue conference has been held 14.01.2026. Tenderers shall compete for the maximum price - NOK 60 million excluding VAT - already with the tender submission. This is directly connected to the municipality's economic framework. Changes to the guaranteed maximum price will be regulated in accordance with the separate mechanisms stated in Annex 1 - Performance Description and contract provisions for the interaction phase and execution phase respectively. After the interaction

phase has ended, a decision will be made as to whether the project will be continued for the execution phase.
