The contracting authorities reserve the right not to make any award and reserves the right to accept all or part of any tender.

Interested parties should be aware that the estate in both Kent and Essex is likely to change / reduce over the term of the contract. Known future changes will be identified in the tender but there are likely to be others and interested parties should therefore be aware of this when submitting their tender. Both authorities are anticipating not having to pay for services where the estate is reduced during the term of the contract.

The Freedom of Information Act (FOI) applies to both police authorities. If any interested parties consider that any information supplied by them is either commercially sensitive or confidential in nature this should be highlighted and the reasons for it's sensitivity specified.
