It underwent significant upgrade and technical refresh activities in the 1990's and early 2000's in order to work with the replacement for ICCS, the United Kingdom (UK) Air Surveillance and Control System (ASACS) Command and Control System (UCCS) and its associated communications infrastructure. The ISDL equipment is used to connect UK ASACS main radio operating sites with their associated transmitter (Tx) and receiver (Rx) sites. The requirement is for a contract for the provision of support services for ISDL until 31.3.2022.
