The National Library of Norway has informed KS Digital that in 2026 funding will be announced to the county libraries, and that this shall go to an incentive scheme for public libraries who would like to procure a joint mediation system. It is further stated that the support scheme is set at NOK 5,000,000 and that the resources are scheduled to be distributed in autumn 2026 as a one-time payment to the counties.
